Secure consoles are regularly emptied by trained and security-vetted staff, before documents are securely destroyed using proprietary cross-cut shredder technology. The entire process is tracked



via a handheld scanning device and a Certificate of Destruction is issued after every shred.

Our document destruction services securely recycle 100% of all shredded paper. Once documents have been destroyed, Shred-it bales all shredded paper and sends it to a paper mill where it is pulped - with impurities and printing ink removed - which is then used to create new paper products.







- Install energy-efficient lighting and switch lights off when they're not in use.

- **Promote sustainable travel.** Rather than drive, encourage employees to bike, walk, take public transport, or even car share.
- If your company has a fleet of vehicles, use energy-efficient models and energy-efficient routes to reduce emissions and fuel consumption.
- Reduce unnecessary business travel and consider video conferencing instead of road or air travel.

- Review your companys packaging of products and condense where possible.
- Only print if necessary! Reduce paper usage by converting as much as possible to digital.
- Put a company recycling programme in place for cans, plastic and glass. Food waste can also be recycled into fertiliser and can even be used to generate electricity.
- For everything else, our document destruction services ensure all paper, old mobile phones, hard drives and data-sensitive electronic media is securely destroyed before recycling.
