Reduce Human Error

A one time document clean-out means that the workspace will no longer have excess documents, files and electronic devices lying around. According to the Shred-it 2020 Data Protection Report, 27% of C-suite executives and 25% of small business owners cite human error or accidental loss by an employee as the primary reason for a breach.



Theft Prevention

Boxes of old files sitting around, years' worth of emails retained on a computer, or confidential information piling up on desks or visible on computer screens are all opportunities for hackers and information thieves. Decluttering your workspace will mitigate some of these risks areas.



Proof of Destruction

Following a one time shred, a professional shredding service provider will issue a Certificate of Destruction. A Certificate of Destruction is given to confirm that the intended materials have been destroyed and that the organization is compliant with relevant laws, such as the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA).
